

# What is Simpler Recycling?

Simpler Recycling is a UK-wide legal framework developed to make the recycling process more straight forward. The main intention of the framework is to create consistency in the waste and recycling materials collected from households and businesses.

The legislation outlines a core set of materials which must be collected, to remove current national recycling scheme inconsistencies and help the UK hit their recycling rate target of 65% by 2035. Recycling these items are not only beneficial to the environment but more cost effective than simply disposing of them, meaning this is a win-win for businesses.

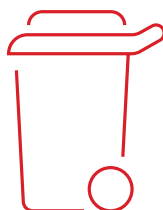
